- a) The funds so disbursed constitute the third of the Financial Year fixed at 24.67% of the annual budget of UNRA.
- b) The quarterly targets and associated budgets tagged thereto are based on submitted program from the UNRA work plan for Q3-FY 2017/18.
- c) Comply with the terms and conditions of the Performance Agreement for FY 2017/18 that you executed with URF.
- d) Priority for maintenance activities within the available resources should be routine manual and mechanized maintenance and bridge maintenance to forestall bottlenecks that occurred on the network.
- e) Avoid new commitments that attract debts beyond the available resources since the declared UGX 40 billion deficit was first call on FY 2017/18 budget and cleared using Q1 funds.



- f) The Uganda Road Fund as a "financier" of Road Maintenance in Uganda holds the Accounting Officer responsible for delivering on the Workplan for Q3 of FY 2017/18 financed herein.
